Ted Arnott was 27 when he was first elected to the Ontario Legislature in 1990. He was re-elected in 1995, 1999 and again in 2003 to represent the riding of Waterloo Wellington.

Ted is a Presiding Officer or Assistant Speaker in the Legislature, holding the position of First Deputy Chair of the Committee of the Whole House. He is the Official Opposition Critic for the Ministry of Tourism and Recreation. He is also a member of the Legislature's Standing Committee on Social Policy.

Ted has been instrumental in the advancement and resolution of many important issues in his community including support for the rights of volunteer fire fighters, the Waterloo-Wellington Transportation Action Plan, repairs to the Conestogo Dam and capital funding for Conestoga College.

Ted and his wife Lisa McCabe have three sons and live in the Fergus area. Firmly rooted in communities he represents, Ted has been described as a “moderate Conservative”. He is a vocal advocate for the people of Waterloo-Wellington who stands up for his riding's interests and values.
