David MacKinnon, our upcoming speaker describes his message as being “a weather report for the Titanic”. It is a warning about the coming dreadful mess in Ontario’s finances, education and health care systems caused by bad federal government transfer policies.

Mr. MacKinnon is a native of Prince Edward Island, received a Bachelor of Arts degree (Honours Economics) from Dalhousie University and his MBA from York University. He was awarded a Centennial Fellowship by the Canadian Imperial Bank of Commerce and York University to study at York, Harvard and Oxford Universities as well as the European Institute of Business Studies.

Mr. MacKinnon served in several senior capacities in the Ontario Public Service and for seven years as CEO of the Ontario Hospital Association. He has recently retired after completing a senior contractual assignment. Mr. MacKinnon serves on or advises several Boards of Directors including the Ontario Chamber of Commerce, for which, he has tabled two reports about “Fairness in Confederation – Fiscal Imbalance”: Phase 1 – “Driving Ontario to Have-Not Status”; and Phase 2 – “A Roadmap to Recovery”.
